Key: 'Rt' = Number of routes run by each player during the 2021 season. 'Proj Tgt%' = Projected target share for the current week. 'LWR/Slot/RWR' = % of the player's routes run from left wide receiver, the slot, and right wide receiver, respectively. 'T/R' = % of a player's pass routes in which he's targeted. 'F/R' = Fantasy points per pass route. For defense, 'snap' indicates the production of receivers lined up against the defender at the snap and 'coverage' refers to the production of receivers when they are in coverage. For the player stats, red (hot) is good and blue (cold) is poor. In the matchup columns, red suggests an advantage for the offensive player and blue an advantage for the defender. 'S' indicates projected shadow coverage.

Key: These rankings indicate how well a defense has performed against wide left, slot and wide right receivers this season in terms of fantasy points allowed per game. "Perimeter" refers to outside receivers, which is wide left and wide right receivers combined. "Overall" is total fantasy points per game allowed. "FPOE" is fantasy points allowed over expected. The darker red the number, the tougher the matchup for the WR. The brighter the blue, the easier the matchup.
